ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ODD FELLOWS HOME OF CALIFORNIA

I

The name of this corporation shall be ODD FELLOWS HOME OF CALIFORNIA.

II

The specific and primary purpose for which this corporation is formed is to own, control, conduct, and manage homes, hospitals and asylums, for the care, maintenance, and support of aged, indigent, or infirm Odd Fellows, their wives and widows, and aged, indigent or infirm, widowed or unmarried members of the Rebekah Degree of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, all in accordance with the rules, regulations, and discipline of the Grand Lodge of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows of the State of California.

III

This corporation shall have all of the rights and powers granted by the laws of the State of California to non-profit corporations, and all such rights and powers are hereby expressly claimed.

IV

This corporation is organized pursuant to the general non-profit corporation law of the State of California, and this corporation does not contemplate the distribution of pecuniary gains, profits or dividends to the members thereof.

V

The county in this state where the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is located is Santa Clara County.

VI

The directors of this corporation shall be known and designated as trustees. The number of directors, to be known as trustees, shall be seven (7). The names and addresses of the persons who are appointed to act as the first trustees of this corporation are:

This corporation shall have no capital stock, and the number and qualifications of members of the corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members and their liability to dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof shall be as set forth in the by laws.

This corporation is organized solely for non-profit purposes. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable or hospital purposes, and upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and/or hospital purposes and whose property is dedicated to exempt purposes as specified in Revenue and Taxation Code Section 214. The non-profit fund, foundation, or corporation, meeting the requirements above set forth, to receive the distribution of the assets of this corporation, shall be selected and designated by the Grand Lodge of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows of California.

IX

The name of the unincorporated association which is being incorporated is ODD FELLOWS HOME OF CALIFORNIA.
